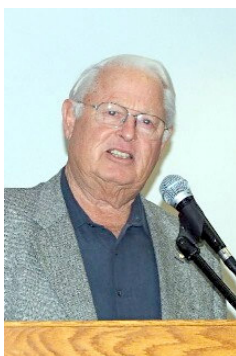
# DR. VIDEO RETURNS

### ROSE FLOAT RAFFLE

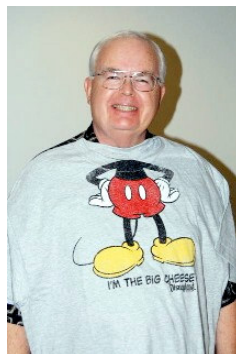
