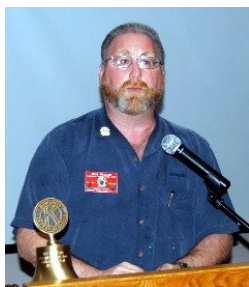
DOC VIDEO DOES HIS THANG
