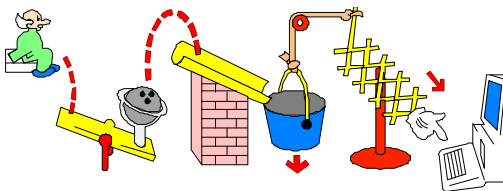

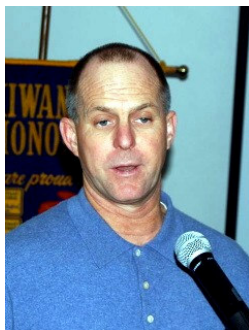
### EVERY WHERE WE GO . . .
