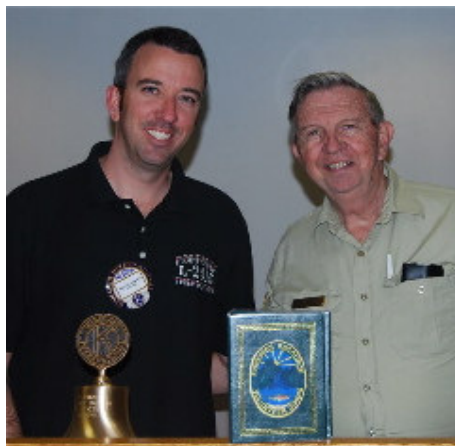
BELATED “WELCOME TO MONROVIA”
